**RE:** Wind and Solar Survey for Immediate Release

The Grayson County Department of Planning and Community Development is currently reviewing the County's policies, goals in the Comprehensive Plan, and regulations contained within the County's Zoning Ordinance having to do with wind and solar energy generation facilities. Such facilities include wind turbines located on mountain ridgelines and utility solar farms with solar panels covering several acres, if not hundreds of acres or more.

The goal of this review is to make sure that the County's policies and regulations:

1. Meet best practice standards for these types of facilities; and
2. Meet the expectations of the County's residents, resulting in projects that can be supported by the community.

To help facilitate the process of creating policies and regulations, a four (4) question survey has been released for those wishing to provide feedback. A link to the survey is below, along with the links to the 2018 Comprehensive Plan and the Grayson County Zoning Ordinance. The survey will be available for 30 days beginning July 29, 2022, and expire on August 29, 2022.
